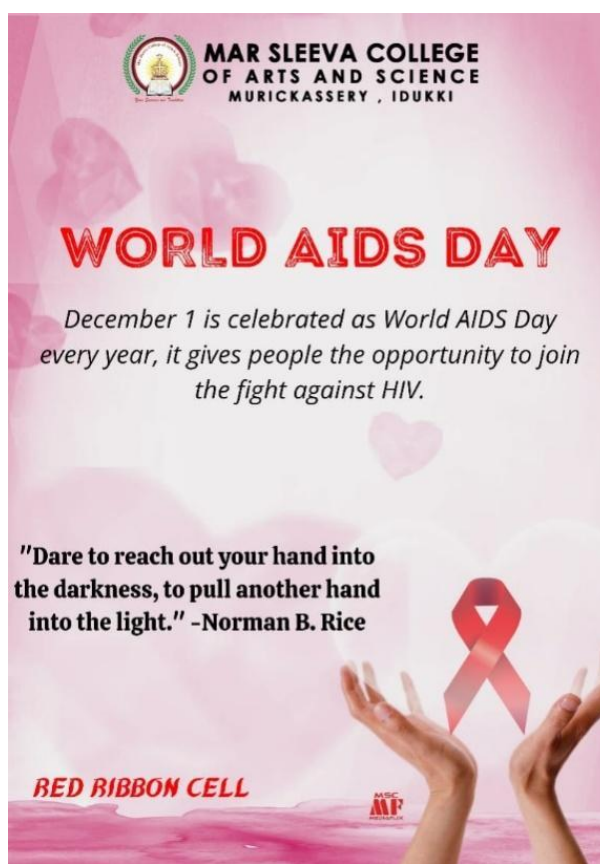


AIDS DAY OBSERVATION
