ACTIVITIES

* Interaction with students of TMV

On 28/12/2022, the social work trainees of maxsleevea college interacted with the students of TMV and exchanged their views and opinions related to Kerala and Maharashtra culture, traditions, social issues etc. presentations were taken by the TMV social work trainees showcasing their field engagements and Kerala culture was presented by trainees of maxsleevea college.

* Community visit.

On 29/12/2022 the social work trainees visited a tribal village named Bahirwadi under the guidance of Mr. Prakash Yadav (CHOD of MSW dep, TMV). The trainees understood various kinds of field engagements and methods of community organization.

* Observation visits.

(i) Poona Geriatric Centre (PGC), Katraj.

The social work trainees visited Poona Geriatric Centre on 30/12/2022 where the orientation class by Dr. Santhosh Kanshite (founder and managing director of the geriatric centre) and interaction with the inmates imparted knowledge about geriatrics to the trainees.

(ii) Mamta Foundations, Katraj.

The foundation was visited on 30/12/2022. It is a residential centre for HIV positive patients between 3 and 80 yrs. The trainees interacted with the residents and entertained them.

(iii) Chaitanya Institute of Mental Health, Pune.

On 02/01/2023 and 03/01/2023, the social work trainees visited Chaitanya Institute of Mental Health, Pune which is a residential psychiatric care centre, established for the acute management and community based psycho social rehabilitation of the mentally ill. The trainees got familiarized with different sections like male and female geriatrics, rehab and de-addiction case studies were also conducted during the period. Deeper knowledge about medical and psychiatric field was acquired by the trainees.

(iv) NIRMAN, Vishrantwadi

The trainees visited the organization NIRMAN on 04/01/2023, which aims to empower nomadic tribes (NT) and denotified tribes (DNT) and bring about social transformation. The role of a social worker in a community based organization was understood by the trainees.
