
























As per the feedback collected from the teachers on need based curriculum and syllabus,100% of the faculties agreed that there is a need based curriculum and syllabus




Based on the assessment conducted among the teachers 100% of the teachers agree that the course outcome was well defined




After analyzing the feedback of teachers 100% of the teachers strongly disagree to the statement there is sufficient number of reading materials and digital recourses in library.




Based on the analysis conducted,75% of the faculties have neutral opinion regarding the balance between theory and application in the course,25% of the agree that there is good balance between theory and application.












