Mar Sleeva College of Arts and Science is affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University endowed with 731 students, 46 teachers and 12 non-teaching staff with 9 Under Graduate and 2 Post Graduate Programmes in 7 streams. DEPARTMENTS

Department of Commerce

Examinations and Results

All the Internal and University Examinations are conducted strictly under CCTV as per the verdict of the Honorable High Court of Kerala and Mahatma Gandhi University Directives. The fourth semester result of the present final years batches of B.Com Taxation, BCA and BA English students secured 80% results and in the fifth semester examination B.Com Taxation secured 100% results and BSC Geology has 99% of success. All other Departments have secured good results.

Special Achievements

Our three faculty members Athul Augustine, Anu Baby from English and Anu Savio from Commerce Department qualified the National Eligibility Test. Amalu Sebastian and Aneeta Tomy, final year BBA students cleared KMAT and Final year BA English student Aleena B cleared the KMAT and CMAT successfully.

We are helping the dressing students to achieve minority welfare scholarships and post metric scholarships. 12 students from different Departments are being provided free education and 16 financially backward students are provided partial concession as a scholarship from Mar Sleevea College. We have instituted the Best Student Award for one student from each class.

Lab and Library

We have well equipped Computer, Geology and Physics labs and a library with vast collection of books.

Installed Amenities

The College established a Digital Conference Hall, a Basket Ball Court and a Volley Ball Court in the premises in the current year under the special interest and concern of College Management. It has been proposed to build a Foot Ball Court this year.

College Union

The College Union election was held on 21st August 2019. Mr. Arun George and Miss Abhirami L.M were selected as Chairman and Vice Chairperson. The Union was inaugurated on 18th December 2019 by Miss Niranjana Anoop, cine artist and the Union assumed their power with the oath taking ceremony.
