Examinations and Results

All the Internal and University Examinations are conducted strictly under CCTV as per the verdict of the Honorable High Court of Kerala and Mahatma Gandhi University Directives. The fourth semester result of the present final years batches of B.Com Taxation, BCA and BA English students secured 80% results and in the fifth semester examination B.Com Taxation secured 100% results and BSC Geology has 99% of success.
