ANNUAL REPORT OF ACADEMIC YEAR 2020-2021

Mar Sleeva College of Arts and Science, affiliated with Mahatma Gandhi University, accommodates a total of 728 students, 50 teachers, and 12 non-teaching staff, offering 9 Under graduate and 2 Postgraduate Programmes across 7 distinct streams. In recognition of the invaluable contributions made by former faculty members, we extend our sincere gratitude, while also extending a warm welcome to the newly appointed staff members.

Re-opening of the College

Due to the Covid 19 Pandemic situation, the College was reopened via online platform on1st June 2020 with 2nd and 3rd U.G and 1 P.G courses with Department wise induction programme to introduce the course and familiarizes online teaching platform to students. 1st U.G classes commenced on 01st November 2020 Via Google Meet. A meeting was conducted for newly admitted students and their parents. The meeting was presided over by Rev. Dr. George Thakadiyel.

Highlights of the Departments

• Department of Geology

The Department of Geology conducted a Poster Making Competition as a part of *World Day against Child Labour* and a Speech Competition as a part of *Doctor's Day* via Google Meet. The Department encourages alumni association and conducted an Alumni talk which paved the way for students to enrol in different paths other than Earth Science. Geology Department has been a part of the Panel Discussion and Debate Competition conducted by Marian International Institute of Management via Google Meet on the topic '*Effective Management of Disaster in Idukki District*' on 25th February 2021. On 27th February the Department conducted an online Quiz Competition as a part of *National Science Day*. On 3rd and 4th march 2021, a Faculty Exchange Programme conducted for the P.G Students. Faculties from Govt. College Nattakam, took classes to the students. The Department also coordinated an Open Interactive Session with Geologists from various field via Google Meet.

• Department of Economics

The Department of Economics has been outstandingly functioning in the College since 2016. This academic year began with an Induction Programme to students via Google Meet to familiarise them about new online classes. An awareness programme conducted as a part of *World Blood Donor's Day* on 16thJune 2020. As a part of reading Day Celebration, the Department organised a Quiz Competition for the students. A Poster Making Competitions on 27th August 2020 and a Debate Competition on 5th November 2020 were also conducted by the Department via Google Meet.

Department of Social Work

The Department conducted webinars on the topic "Emerging Trends in Global Social Work" on 21st January 2021 and further they conducted webinar on the topic "Embedding Child Rights into Practice Legal Perspectives" on 30th January 2021. The Department organised a street play as a part of *Women's Day* Celebration and arranged a rural camp at Marayoor from 22nd march to 27th March.

• Department of Commerce

The Commerce Association serves as a platform to give its students awareness about the current business world, various trade activities and challenges faced by the corporate world. The activities of Commerce Association for the academic year commenced with One Day National Webinar on "Academic Publications-How to Write Research Paper" on 15/06/2020 by Dr. O.C Aloyius, Principal, Govt. College Kattappana. The Department took initiatives to organise various competitions via online platform like Tagline competitions, singing competitions, Elocution competition, Drawing competition and PPT presentation competition. The Department conducted various training programmes on group discussion, virtual interview training workshop, and a webinar on GST.
