Graph IV: Regarding the usage of teaching aids and ICT in the class by faculty to facilitate teaching, $40 \%$ students commented an excellent opinion and $35 \%$ gave a very good attitude to the question. It was v good and fair in the perspective of $10 \%$ students, and remaining $5 \%$ gave poor response.

Graph V: Students were asked to rate how fair the assessment processes are $85 \%$ of students gave an excellent remark. $10 \%$ of students observed that fairness in assessment processes was very good. $5 \%$ opined good.

Graph VI: This graphical representation shows the comments of the students about the timely announcement of examination results. The percentage of students commented excellent is $50 \%$ and students commented very good $20 \%$. $15 \%$ of students commented good and fair respectively.

Graph VII : Majority of the students have a very good opinion on the opportunities in the school/university for research activities. . Only $25 \%$ of students were satisfied and gave an excellent and very good comment. $20 \%$ of students voted for good. $15 \%$ commented fair and poor respectively.

Graph VIII : On considering the opportunities for students to participate in internship, student exchange and field visit, majority gave an excellent opinion, $10 \%$ of respondents gave very good and good opinion.

Graph IX: This graph is the ratings given by the students regarding the opportunities out of class learning (Guest lectures, seminars, workshop, value added programs, conferences, competitions). 75\% of the total number of students commented excellent, and $15 \%$ gave a very good opinion. $10 \%$ of the students opined good.

Graph X : This graphical representation shows the responses of the students about the overall learning experience. $75 \%$ commented excellent and $20 \%$ of students commented very good. $5 \%$ students responded
good.
