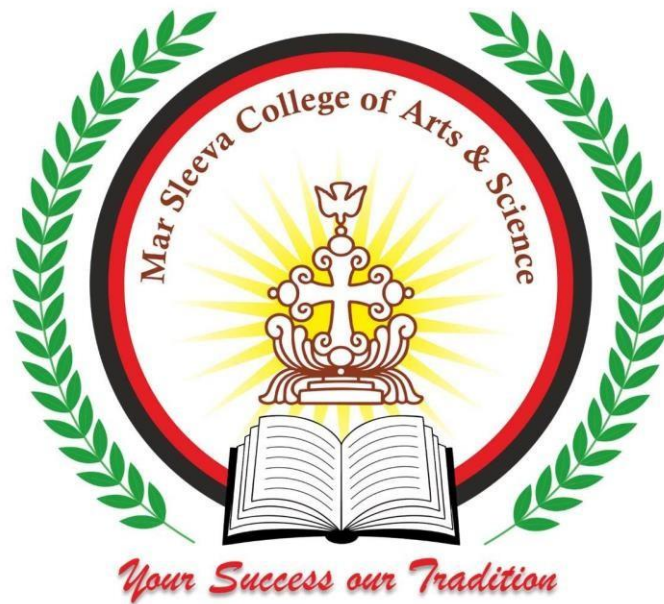

Program Outcome

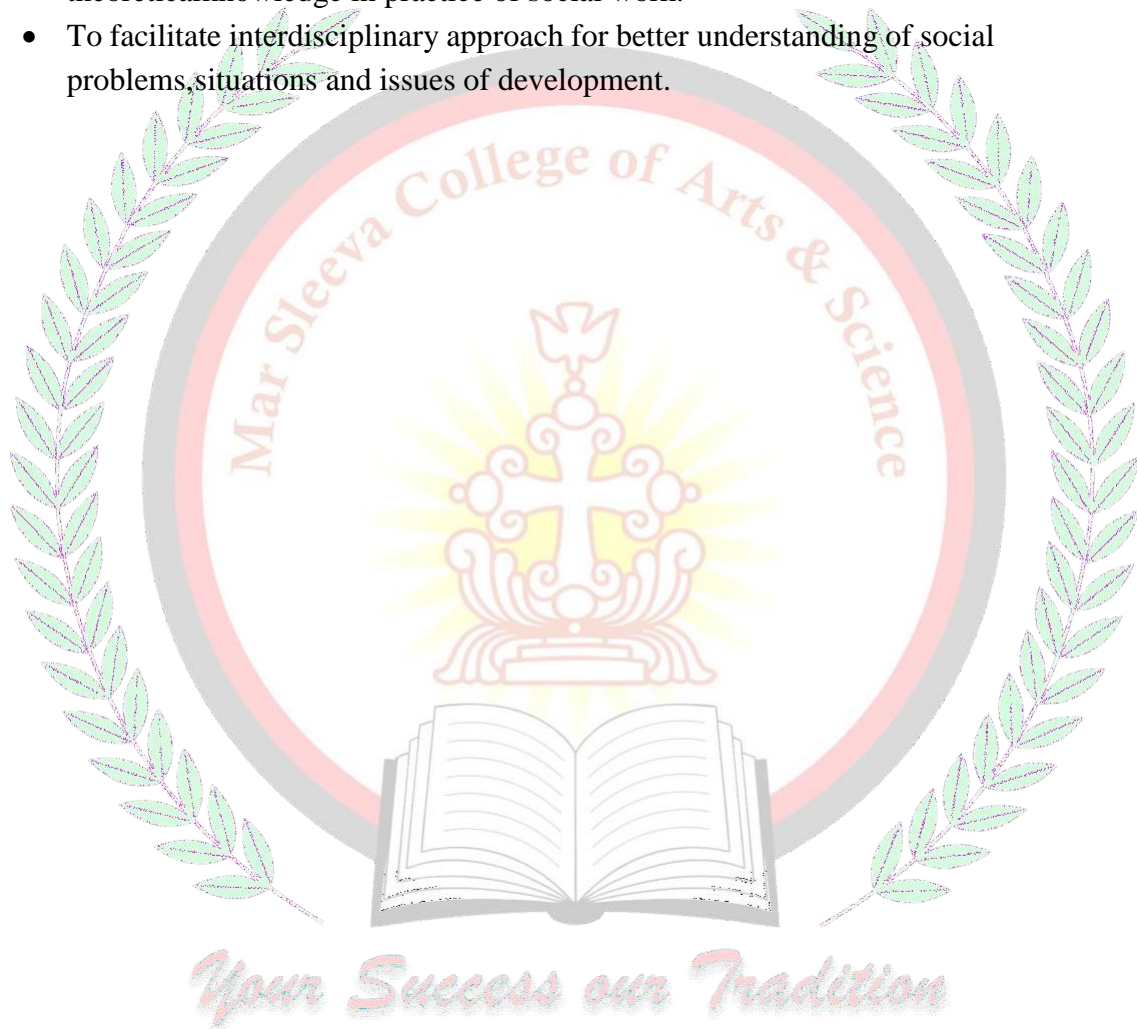
