### RE-OPENING OF THE COLLEGE

The College was reopened after summer vacation through online platform due to Covid-19 pandemic situation, on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2021 with 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year UG and 2<sup>nd</sup> P.G courses. 1<sup>st</sup> year UG classes commenced on 27<sup>th</sup> September 2021. A meeting for newly admitted students with their parents was conducted via Google Meet. The meeting was presided over by Rev. Fr.
