Highlights of the Departments:

Department of Geology

Department conducted awareness Seminar and Photography Competitions on the World Asteroid Day and the World Moon Day respectively. The Department encourages the alumni association and conducted an Alumni Talk which has paved the way for the students to enrol in paths other than just Earth Science. The Department also coordinated an open interactive session with the Geologists from various field.

Department of Economics

The Department has been outstandingly functioning in the College since 2016. This academic year began with “An Awareness Programme on Financial Literacy” by the Centre for Financial Literacy and other various programmes like Debate, Inter-departmental Slogan Writing Competition, Remembrance of Freedom Fighters and Inter-departmental Letter Writing Competition.

Department of Social Work

The Department aims at fostering practical skills and knowledge of the students in their field. Under the guidance and supervision of the HOD, Fr. Jossy Puthuparambil, various programmes were initiated like *Inter College Tribal Fest* conducted at Adimali, ASER Survey Programme, an International Conference held in Kozhikode and different awareness classes to the students of SPC mainly. The Department took part in student exchange programme with Tilak Maharashtra University Pune and submitted two projects for Oorja Kiran and have taken its initiative. In order to spread the awareness about HIV/ AIDS a skit was organized at Medical College, Idukki. A Street Play also performed by the Social Work trainees in the emergence of drug in present scenario by promoting the slogan “Say No to Drug”. The Department of Social Work secured *Overall Championship* in the *Inter-Collegiate Competitions* conducted at Don Bosco College, Sulthan Bathery.

Department of Commerce

Commerce Association of our College serves as a platform to give its students awareness about the current business world, various trade activities and challenges faced by the corporate world. The activities of Commerce Association for this academic year, was inaugurated on 24th June 2022 in the College Conference Hall by Rev. Fr. Mathew Thadathil, the Director Heads and former Principal of the College. The Department conducted an induction programme and bridge course to first year students. As a part of Onam celebrations, Commerce Association organized a “Chinga Kasavu” (which includes Mega Thiruvathira, Malayali Manka and Kerala Sreeman). Apart from these activities, the Association also

Service Entry Coaching Club

Tourism Club

As part of World Tourism Day Celebrations the Club conducts seminars, talk shows and discussions on the importance of tourism. Apart from competitions, the Club organizes various

programmes like field visits, industrial visits and tour programmes to various places like Wayanad, Ernakulam, Karnataka, Goa, and Dindigul.

MSC Sports Club

MSC Sports Club conducted Tug of War and Arm Wrestling as part of Onam celebrations. It also conducted Cricket and Football team selection for the students of MSC. Selected candidates got the opportunity to participate in the University Competitions. MSC Sports Club actively participated in the 'One million Goal Campaign' conducted by the Government of Kerala against drugs. Idukki Block Sports Meet was conducted in the College in association with Nehru Yuva Kendra Idukki. The Sports items included Volleyball, Football, 100 m - boys and 100 m girls. A Basketball Competition was also held between Mar Sleevians and Stars Idukki.
